#### We apologise for the delays

Unfortunately, we're unable to start this phase of the project as soon as we'd planned. We apologise for any frustration this may cause to residents and road users.

Although work is starting a bit later than planned, it means Stage 1 will be completed sooner - this delay has come about because we took some extra time to improve our planned approach to this section of construction, based on what our survey of the site told us. This change will let us be more efficient, allowing us to finish this section faster while saving money. However, it's meant we had to amend our consent, which we now have verbal confirmation has been granted and as soon as the formalities have been received, we will be commencing work on the pathway. In the meantime, we plan to start reconstruction of the Bay View Road intersection, please turn over for more information on this work. While the consent was being revised, we prepared the site for sheet piling, completed the seawall protection and removal of the rock wall, removed the Rifle Range Stream bridge, and created our site compound, fencing, and line marking. We've temporarily restricted pedestrian access on the estuary side while we remove the heritage rock wall. The wall will be restored later. # Why are we removing the rock wall?

To bring in the machinery we'll use to complete the Coastal Pathway, we need to temporarily remove the damaged heritage rock wall. We've used a breaker to carefully remove the existing rock, so we can reuse it in the construction of the new wall at a later date. We've installed temporary cover to the remaining wall to protect it.



#### **Coastal Pathway - Moncks Bay**

#### What are we doing?

We will be sheet piling into the ocean side of the existing pathway. Sheet piling is the process of driving metal sheets into the ground using a large machine. These sheets will create a barrier to allow us to work along the coastline. We will be in touch once the dates are confirmed. We will also be working in Bay View Road. We will be reconstructing the entrance to Bay View Road which includes drainage, kerb and channel and footpaths. This work will require Bay View Road to be closed from **Monday 28 February** for approximately 4 weeks.

### **Traffic Impacts**

Two lanes of traffic will be maintained on Main Road during the sheet piling process but please be on the lookout for changes to the traffic management and follow the signs. In some locations, cyclists will merge with traffic so please be patient and keep an eye out for other road users.

There will be no access in or out via Bay View Road at the intersection of Main Road from Monday 28 February for approximately 4 weeks. Detours will be available via Wakatu Ave so please follow the detour signs.

Our friendly on-site staff can also assist with any queries. Driveway and pedestrian access will be maintained around our work site. The speed limit around our work site is 30kph to keep our workers safe.

We know this work is disruptive so we appreciate your patience and understanding. Thanks for your cooperation.


